- Lloyds Ave (Carlingford)



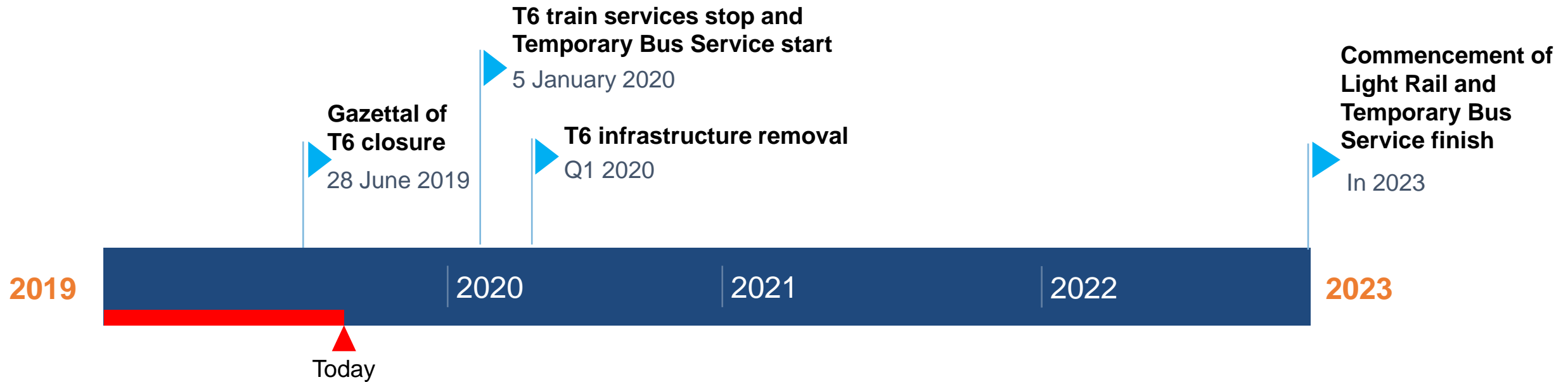
Figure 15.2, Parramatta Light Rail Stage 1 EIS, Volume 1B

Temporary Bus Service Timeline





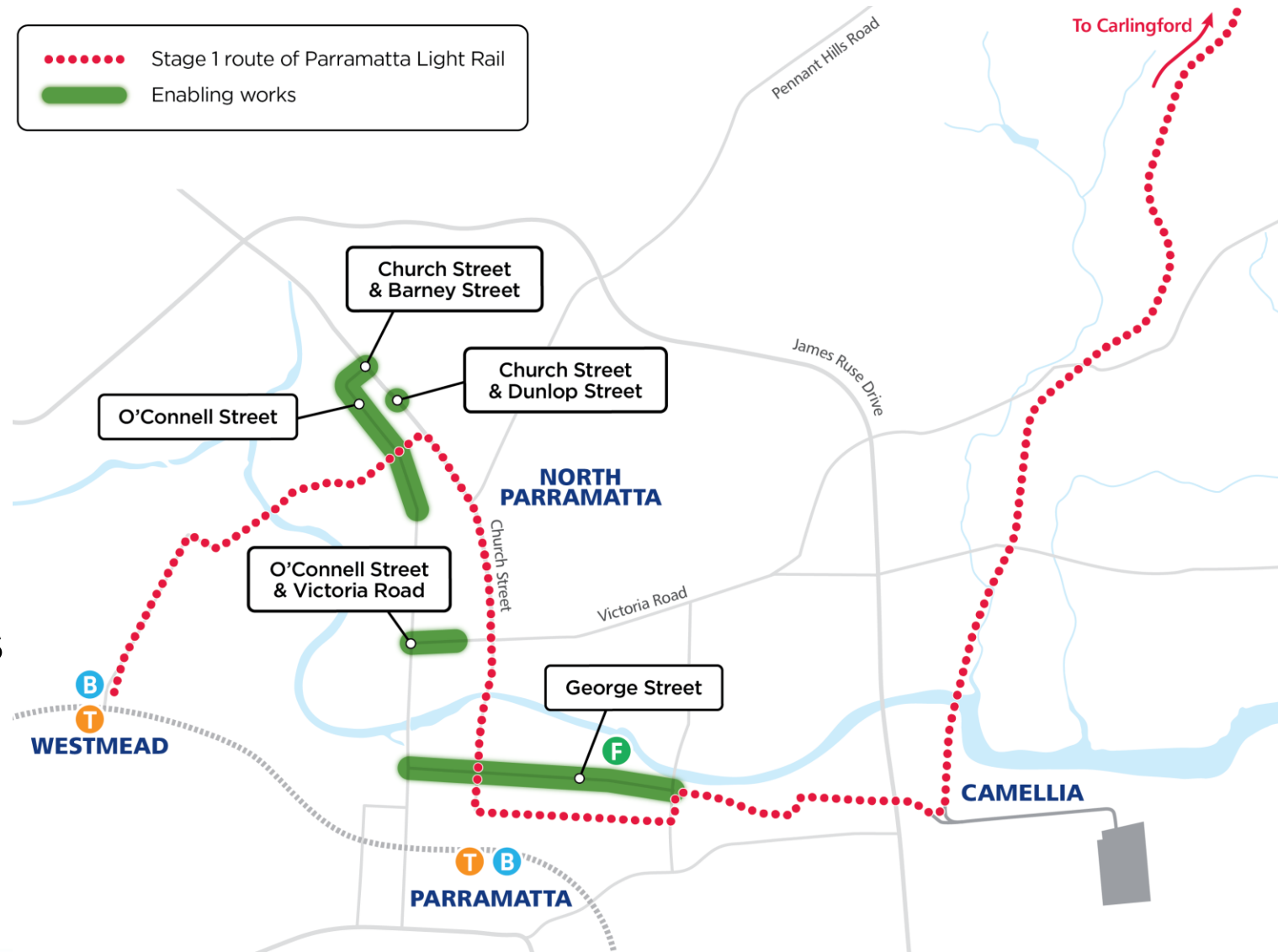

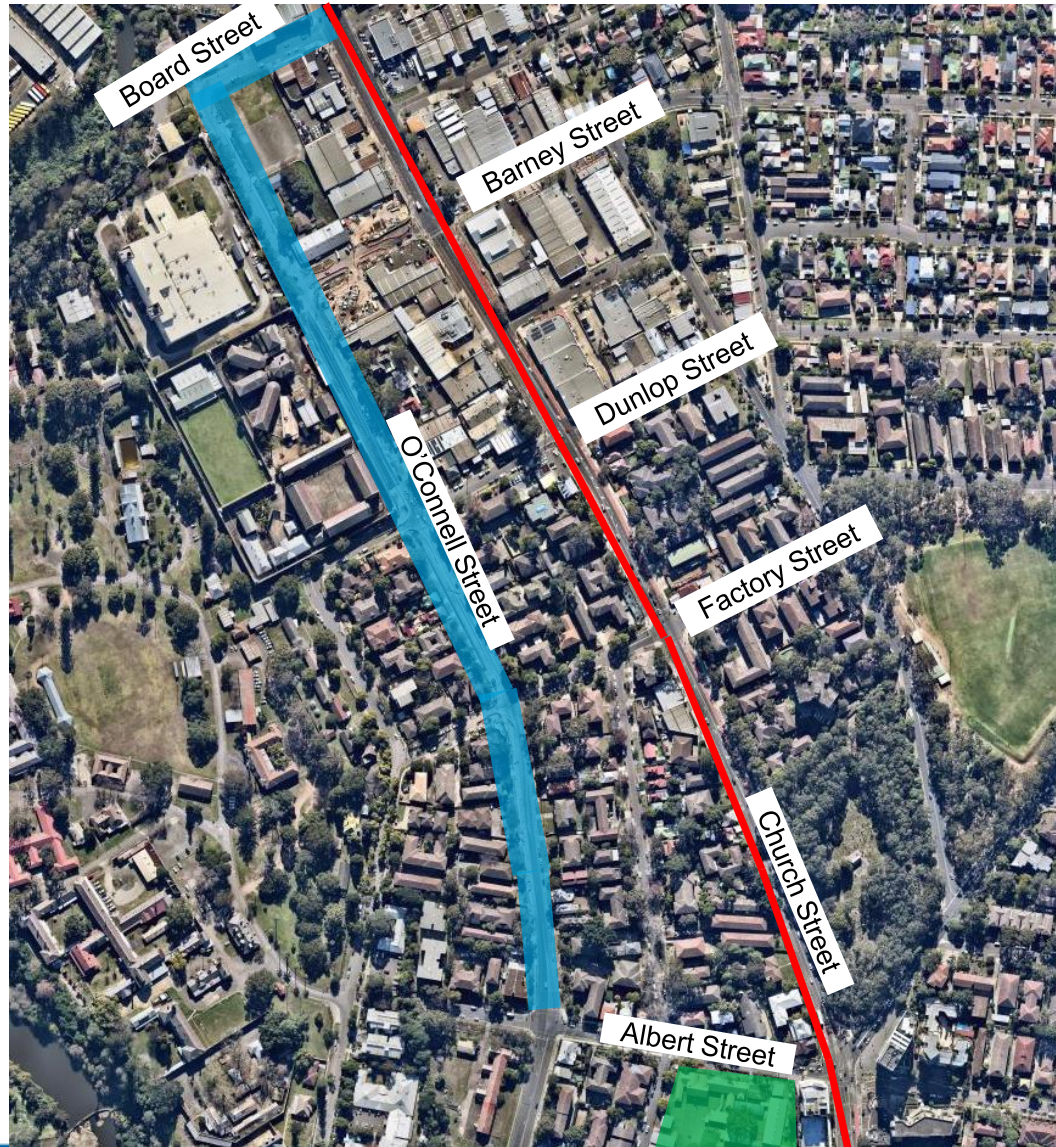
Enabling Works - Overview





Works are currently underway and involve:

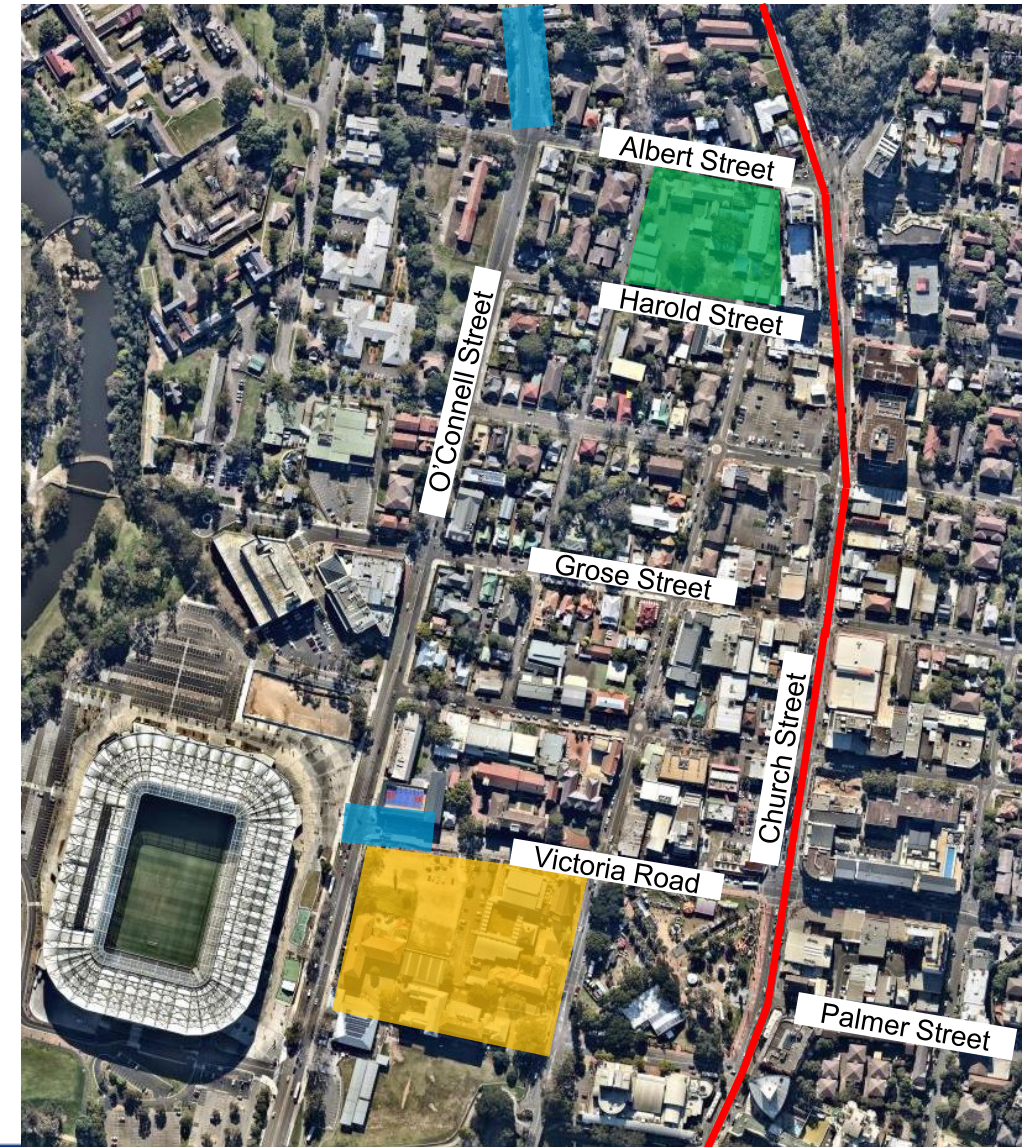
- Heritage investigations
