Photocopy of Valid Science 8 and/or Valid Science 10 if available. Not all schools take part in these tests.	
Photocopy of Selective Schools test or OC test results if available.	
Photocopies of external academic achievements for the past 2 years . These may include for example ICAS, RACI or AMT competition results. Include the detailed results as well as the certificate with your final (eg High Distinction, Distinction) result.	
Photocopies of evidence of participation in extracurricular activities . This might include activities such as chess, music, debating, sport, drama etc.	
JRAHS Additional Information Form . This is to be completed by the student in the student's own handwriting. No additional pages may be attached.	
<p>For entry to years 8, 9, 10 and 11 in 2022</p> <p>\$110 application fee paid direct to Edutest using the link on our website. The entrance test is planned for Saturday 24 July 2021 commencing at 9:00am. You must bring a photo ID on the day of the test. Acceptable ID includes current school photo/library card or passport. Also bring two lead pencils and a black or blue pen. No calculators are permitted.</p>
